# Northern Ontario Is Church Leader's First Stop on Spirit Express Journey

Toronto: North Bay will be the first stop for The United Church of Canada's Moderator, Mardi Tindal, as she begins a month-long journey inviting people to come together to talk about their concerns for the environment.

Tindal's journey was named the Spirit Express because she intentionally scheduled this leg of her regional visits so that her travel between the provinces of Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta could be done exclusively by train. She chose this means of transportation as a way of reducing her carbon footprint during her three-year term when she knew she would be travelling extensively.

Tindal, who arrives in North Bay on Tuesday, October 12, at 1:50 p.m., will be met at the train station by local United Church representatives, who will accompany her to a welcome reception at The United Church of Canada's Manitou Conference Office at 319 McKenzie Avenue.

In addition to her stop in North Bay, Tindal will be visiting Callander and Sudbury, and hosting Spirit Express town hall meetings in Powassan and Chapleau.

Members of the media and the general public, including those of other faith traditions, are welcome to attend these town hall meetings.
