Toronto: Saskatchewan will be the next stop for The United Church of Canada's Moderator, Mardi Tindal, as she continues a month-long journey inviting people to come together to talk about their concerns for the environment.

Tindal's journey was named the Spirit Express because she intentionally scheduled this leg of her regional visits so that her travel between the provinces of Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta could be done exclusively by train. She chose this means of transportation as a way of reducing her carbon footprint during her three-year term when she knew she would be travelling extensively.

Tindal boards the train for Saskatchewan in Winnipeg at 12:00 noon on Monday, October 25. She arrives in Melville at 5:32 p.m. During her time in Saskatchewan, Tindal will be visiting Kipling, Kindersley, Regina, and Saskatoon.
